Francis House Mixed Greensome Rules and Format



Each of the competing teams will be invited to have two couples playing in each event. **Teams can play together as a fourball. (this is a change to the original rules to assist teams fielding friends as substitutes)**
The couples do not have to be same players on each occasion.

Handicaps;

Full handicaps Gentlemen maximum 28. Ladies maximum 36. Handicaps will be added together and 50% of the combined total will be allocated to the couple.
All players must have an approved Handicap Certificate

The Format is Mixed Greensome Stableford

Greensomes is a competition format that is a variation of foursomes (2-person teams, each playing one ball). In Greensomes, both players on a team tee off, the best of the two tee balls is selected and that ball is then played alternate-shot until holed.
Gents White tees, Ladies Red tees.

At the conclusion of each event the scoring for the league will be as follows;
The best score from each team will attain league points which will be awarded as follows;
First 20 points, Second 19 points, Third 18 points, Fourth 17 points,
Fifth 16 points, Sixth 15 points. Seventh 14 points, Eighth 13 points,
Ninth 12 points and Tenth 11 point. Eleventh to Twentieth 10 points reducing to 1 point.

In the event of teams finishing with the same total, the points will be split. For instance joint winners will share 39 points, 19.5 points each.

The winners of the Francis House Trophy will be the team with the most league points at the end of play on Sunday 29th August.

On each Sunday there will be prizes for the top four couples.
