Splash Out

Event Rules

Within these rules a "Participant" means an individual who is a competitor in the Splash Out Event.

- All children must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult or carer
- All Participants should consider bypassing an obstacle if you lack confidence or are carrying an injury
- All Participants must ensure that the approach and the obstacle are clear from obstruction
- All Participants must adhere to all instructions given by Event Officials
- Should a Participant choose to help another Participant during the Event they should do so carefully and with their consent
- Participants must not attempt any Stunts during the Event
- Participants should pay attention to their surroundings, keeping head, arms and hands clear of any protrusions
- Participants should spot their landing before jumping or lowering themselves from an obstacle and move away from the obstacle promptly
- Participants must only complete the obstacle once
- Participants must not rush, barge or jostle with other participants
- Participants must comply with all health and safety and other instructions given to them by the organiser's officers, employees and volunteers and use any equipment as directed so as not to hurt or injure others.
- 'Any Participant found to be intoxicated (either through alcohol or drugs) will be prohibited from taking part in the Event'
- Participants must show respect to our staff, volunteers and other participants.
- Participants should use the litter facilities available within and round the course and in the event village.

- Participants should note that dogs are allowed at the Splash Out event, however they must be on a lead at all times, remain in the event village and any fouling must be cleaned up and disposed of in one of the litter facilities.
- We reserve the right to ask Participants and supporters to leave an Event if they do not adhere to these rules, and no refunds will be given in these circumstances.
- Alderley Park is a private park; therefore, all spectators must remain on the event village site.
- Participants must wear their event wristband whilst on site at the Splash Out event.
- Participants should note that Splash Out is a non-competitive family fun day
- Participants should ensure they wear appropriate clothing and footwear when taking part in Splash Out.
- By participating in Splash Out I agree to being photographed and/or to be included in the filming of imagery recording the Event and/or to be included in sound recordings of the event. I hereby waive any and all rights of publicity or privacy and hereby grant to Francis House Family Trust the full and complete permission and authority to utilise my appearance in the Event in all manners of media.
- All participants must sign a waiver prior to the event, failure to do so could result in your place being cancelled with no refund.
