Our memory day in May was blessed by beautiful weather and over a hundred and fifty families joined us in the gardens. As I chatted with people in the sunshine. I thought how remarkable people are, all of these families, here to remember children who had recently died. how heavy their hearts must have been and vet for the sake of those that they love, they put on a brave face and make sure that the people around them don't miss out on life. The staff at Francis House are privileged to walk alongside these courageous people in their darkest times

So many people have struggled psychologically during the pandemic and the years that followed. Long before COVID-19 the Trustees had commissioned a piece of work from Manchester University to explore the effect that having a sibling with a life-limiting condition has on teenagers and young adults.

The results of this research has now been presented to the Trustees and the decision has been taken to expand our once limited psychotherapy service. Some storerooms and former offices next to the hall have been converted into a Psychotherapy suite.

Our lead psychotherapist is delivering bespoke training to our care team to enhance their skills. In addition. the Shining Stars team who provide support for bereaved brothers and sisters has set up a new group 'Shooting Stars' which is a reunion group so that the young people can keep in touch. Once again, we are developing new services to meet the changing needs of our families.

This brings me full circle to where I started this editorial, the wonderful hard work of fundraisers, in house and out in the community and the generosity of our thousands of supporters, whose commitment to Francis House gives us the confidence to carry on even in these difficult economic times.

A SAFE PLACE TO TALK

We all need emotional support at Gio Castro different times in our lives, family and friends are the main people who provide this support.

If you have a life-limiting or life-threatening condition or are a parent or sibling of a person with a serious medical condition, you may need additional support from people who are independent of your family.

For a young person it can be difficult to talk to their close family about their own feelings and fears regarding their future. Our care team members at Francis House have additional training and experience to provide the extra support that is needed at various times in a young person's life.

Gio Castro, member of the Emotional Support Team explains: "It is important for the young people to feel that it's okay to open up about their thoughts and feelings, about their deterioration and their death. It is hard to hear, but our role at Francis House is to make them feel that it's okay to talk and that they've got someone to turn to." Kate Snape has been coming to Francis House since she was seven years old. Despite having a degenerative neuromuscular condition she fulfilled her ambition of studying at university. Kate has spinal muscular atrophy (SMA) Type 2, osteoporosis and dislocated hips.

Kate says: "I found out at an early age that my condition would eventually kill me and that it would never get better. I was always going to struggle physically and be in pain. I went to mainstream schools and was the only child in a wheelchair all the way through primary school and part of high school and sometimes that was difficult to live with.

It's hard to explain what it's like to need other people to do things for you, when you want to do it yourself. A lot of the time people can look at you like you're stupid, or you're lazy, and that's not nice, but you don't have a choice but to live that way and to need the help of other people." "Francis House has always excelled in offering compassion and understanding. As I've got older I've come to terms with the fact that I am different in a way to a lot of people. It is a full time job to live with a condition like mine and incredibly draining. Even though I'm only 25, I know that I have lived longer than anyone expected.

When I was 20, at university I had a party called the "Kate Didn't Die Party", and none of my friends could understand that. When I come here, it's understood how big a deal that is for me to have lived this long. To have people to talk to about it, and be completely honest about how terrifying it is to live with and to grow up with that over your head. I've made friends here who have passed, who were incredibly important to me and it's difficult to talk about that with people I know.

It's only when I'm here I feel like I can really be honest about the fact that I feel guilty, and I struggle with the knowledge that I'm still here. But at Francis House it's nice to feel understood and to be honest with people who see that every day."
