

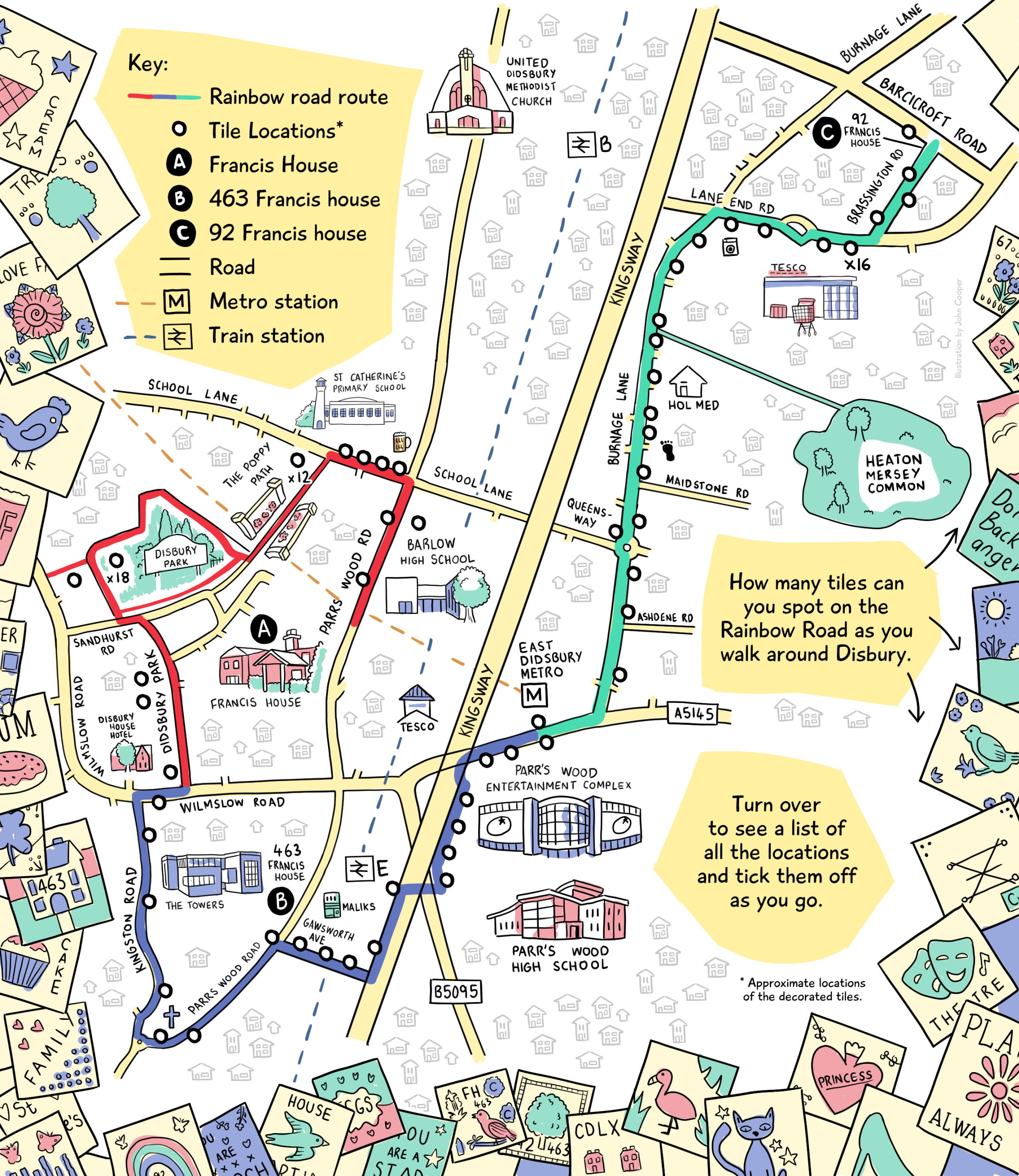
Francis House Rainbow Road Trail
